BY TAKING PART, YOU'RE HELPING AUSTRALIANS LIKE CHARLI GET BACK TO SCHOOL

In May 2020, Charli was diagnosed with blood cancer at just nine years of age. She was taken out of school, and the Sydney Children's Hospital became her new home. After nearly 18 months of treatment and living in and out of hospital, she returned to school in November 2021. To help support more families like theirs, Charli and her family took part in the World's Greatest Shave in 2021 and raised an incredible \$128.340.

I feel unbelievably proud of every single person who got involved. Because of them, the Leukaemia Foundation can keep up their search for a cure and continue improving the lives of Australians living with blood cancer. It was an experience that we'll never forget, and one that bought so much love and richness into our lives during a really tough time.

SHAVE

Enjoy the buzz of shaving your hair. We suggest clipper length number one or two, but if you're opting for a slightly longer hairdo, choose three or four.

CUT

Lop off your locks and enjoy a fresh new hairstyle. Whether it's a pixie cut, a fade, a bob, or something else, you'll be a walking, talking billboard for blood cancer support and research.

COLOUR

Try out that hair colour you've always wanted, and let blood cancer patients know you're in their corner.

FIVE TIPS GIVE YOUR FUNDRAISING A BOOST

Each member of your school team will still have their own personal fundraising page that will count towards your school's overall tally.

Sharing your fundraising page on your socials or via email is a quick and easy way to receive donations. Not sure what to say? You can find a message template in your dashboard.

GIVE · YOUR HAIR A SECOND LIFE

By donating the hair you and your team members Cut or Shave, you can take your impact even further. We've teamed up with Sustainable Salons to recycle your hair into charitable wigs for Australians with cancer.

Hair too short for a ponytail? We can still transform your hair clippings into floating hair booms to mop up oil spills in our oceans.

Last time around, our community donated 9,156 ponytails. That's enough to make 458 wigs for patients who have lost their due to treatment.

How to donate hair

Ponytails that are a minimum of 20cm, dry, tied at the top, middle and bottom (coloured hair is okay) are to be placed into a zip lock bag and posted to:

GET YOUR PRINCIPAL OR STAFF INVOLVED

To kick off your school's World's Greatest Shave event, get your principal or another school staff member to Shave, Cut or Colour their hair as the curtain-raiser.

AUCTION OFF THE HONOURS

Is your principal taking part? Auction off the honour of Shaving, Cutting, or Colouring your principal's hair in front of the entire school to the highest bidder. We think there'll be some demand for this.

YOUR EVENT

SHARE YOUR BIG DAY ON YOUR SOCIALS

Go viral on social media by livestreaming your school's event. Or simply share the best moments online after the event to attract more donors.

ORGANISE A RAFFLE FOR YOUR EVENT

Reach out to local businesses to donate a prize or gift voucher for a raffle. Then spread the word on your socials and sell raffle tickets in exchange for a \$5 or \$10 donation.

GET CREATIVE

When it comes to fundraising, the bigger the better. Prepare a delicious spread, book a food truck, or organise a game of school trivia or cricket. All in the name of blood cancer support and research.

EVENT DAY CHECKLIST

- Ensure your school is equipped with the right range of clippers.
- Organise for some helpers for set up and pack down.
- Get fitted with some World's Greatest Shave merchandise from our online store.
- If you're Colouring, make sure you've got your hair spray and disposable gloves.
- Bring extension cords, brooms, garbage bags, capes and a mirror.
- Bring along your QR code poster and tent card for last-minute donations.
- Do some decorating with some bunting and posters that you'll find in your dashboard.
- Send one last message to your donors and let them know your big day has arrived.
