

Terms and Conditions related to delivery of Nvoke Future Learning prizes

1. The top 3 fundraising schools will be determined at 12noon EST on Monday 3 June 2019 based on the current verified fundraising total of each registered school.
 - a. Schools must register and fundraise as a stand-alone school and may not amalgamate with partner, sister or affiliated schools. Fundraising total must be for the registered school only. **Updated 18 April 2019*
2. Day care centres, universities and kindergartens are not eligible for the School Awards.
3. The top 3 fundraising schools will be advised of their award via email from the Leukaemia Foundation.
4. The highest fundraising school will have the option to choose their award from the three awards; the second highest fundraising school will get choice of the remaining two awards, and the third highest fundraising school will be allocated the remaining award.
5. Awards must be redeemed between 1 July 2019 and 30 June 2020. The timeframe for the redemption of all Awards needs to be agreed upon by all parties.
6. Schools receiving an award agree to being included in Nvoke Future Learning marketing materials (including print and digital media / social media). This may include photographs taken during the redemption of awards.
7. The Robotics Program or Hackathon Event will be designed in consultation with the successful school. The Robotics course is for the delivery of the course only, and does not include a robot as part of the award.
8. Access to Mindprint is for a one off use and is not an ongoing licence. It does include a report and recommendations for each student and teacher and access to the Free Toolbox but does not include access to any other applications / learning support.
9. For the Collaborative Classroom, at the end of the 1 Term Award period, all items supplied as part of the Award will be collected by Nvoke Future Learning.
10. The school will arrange for all appropriate insurances in the event of any loss, theft or damage.
11. The Collaborative Classroom is for a standard classroom size (up to 30 students), and includes the design process and technology implementation, which will be agreed on in consultation with the successful school.
12. Awards are non-transferable, non-exchangeable and not redeemable for cash. Nvoke Future Learning may substitute the awards with any other item of similar value.
13. Nvoke Future Learning and its affiliates shall not be liable in any way to any person for any loss, damage or injury arising from or in connection with these awards.
