Ask everyone

Family and friends should be the first on your list as well as classmates, colleagues and local businesses. You can raise \$560 in just seven steps (enough to give a regional family a free place to stay close to treatment in the city for a week). Head to worldsgreatestshave.com/tips to learn how.

Put the collection box into action

Put your posters up and leave a collection box on the counter at your work, school or club. Then send a message around asking people to put in some money. Put a bag of lollies next to it to tempt them into donating.

Donations make the best gifts

Got a birthday or another celebration coming up? Ask everyone to make a donation to your shave instead of buying a gift.

Raffle it

Organise a raffle! Talk to people in your local community and see if they'll donate a prize. Places like your local café might donate a voucher for breakfast, the nearest cinema might donate movies passes. It could be as simple as putting together a basket full of treats you've baked at home.

Sell, sell, sell

Boost your fundraising by selling goodies from the World's Greatest Shave online shop. Put a little 'pack' together of wristbands, water bottles and balloons and add whatever else you like e.g. lollypops, chocolate, chips.

Get baking or sizzling

An oldie but a goodie! Bake heaps of delicious treats and sell them at work or school, or hold a BBQ and ask for a donation to enjoy lunch. Easy!

Easy events to boost cash

Ideas for mini-events include hosting an afternoon tea with delicious delicacies, clearing out the shed for a garage sale, sorting out the wardrobe for a frock auction over morning tea, offer to do odd jobs in return for donations – walking the neighbour's dog is a good one!!

Donate your tips

Work in the hospitality industry? Donate your tips to your shave, or ask your boss and workmates if the contents of the tip jar can go towards your shave.

Talk to your boss

See if your employer will match your fundraising! Get the whole organisation involved (form a big team and get shaving together!) then hold your shave at work so everyone can cheer you on.

DID YOU KNOW

Shavers who ask for a specific amount raise nearly twice as much as those who ask generally. Your sponsors will be more generous if they understand the impact their donation will make to Aussie families.

\$30 can give families a tailored information pack to help them face their blood cancer challenge

\$53 means the Leukaemia Foundation can visit someone in hospital to help them overcome their fears about treatment

\$64 can help someone learn about their cancer and have a better quality of life

\$80 can give a regional family a home for a night to reduce the financial burden of city treatment

\$120 can support a blood cancer research project for a day through a PhD scholarship grant
